Parent Statement for No Annually Updated Medical Statement for Students with Special Dietary Needs

Madison Consolidated Schools participates in the USDA School Breakfast Program (SBP) and USDA National School Lunch Program (NSLP), and must serve meals meeting the SBP and NSLP requirements.

Reasonable modifications **within** the USDA meal pattern will be made for students with a disability/physical impairment when supported by a Medical Statement signed by a health care provider with prescriptive authority, such as a physician, or the parent.

Reasonable modifications **outside** the USDA meal pattern will be made for students with a disability/physical impairment, such as Celiac Disease, a single food allergy, or texture modification, when supported by a Medical Statement signed by a health care provider with prescriptive authority, such as a physician.

I certify that my student's dietary requirements have not changed since the most recent Medical Statement that is on file at my student's school. I understand that the school will continue to follow the recommendations of the most current Medical Statement on file at the school.

I will not be submitting an updated Medical Statement unless there are changes required by the physician or medical authority.
