Rykers' Ridge Elementary

Arrival

- Car rider students will enter the building through the main entrance.
 - **Parents are not permitted in the building and will need to stay in their vehicle.**
- One PreK teacher will meet each PreK student at the door and walk the student to the PreK room.
- Kindergarten, Grades 1, and 2 will distance in the gym and be supervised by staff.
- Grades 3 and 4 will distance in the cafeteria and be supervised by staff.
- Students will use sanitizer when entering the building.

Meals

Breakfast - 7:35 a.m.

- Grab and go breakfast will be served in the classroom.

Lunch -10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

- PreK will eat in classrooms.
- Kindergarten will eat in the cafeteria with distance between students.
- Grades 1 & 2 will eat in the cafeteria during second lunch shift with distance between students.
- Grades 3 & 4 will eat in the cafeteria during third lunch shift with distance between students.
- No snacks will be sold at lunch.
- No outside visitors will be admitted for lunch.
- All meals will be packaged, and served to students following cafeteria protocol.
- Food Services team will enter lunch codes, take payments, and sanitize accordingly.

Recess

- Everyone will wash hands before going outside and when they re-enter the building.
- One class will be permitted in the play area at a time and will be supervised by the teacher.

Shared Spaces

Classroom

- All rooms have been deep cleaned over the summer by custodians.
- Student supplies will be kept in school boxes assigned to individual students.
- **Unless a space allows for proper physical distancing,** Specials teachers will hold specials classes in classrooms:
 - PE will be held outdoors when possible. When weather does not permit, it will be in the gym. Gym and equipment will be cleaned after each use.
 - Interventions will be held in classrooms if possible. If a student or students receive interventions in the hallways or intervention room, the area will be sanitized between uses.
 - Special education teachers will follow student IEP and provide services while sanitizing between students or groups of students.
 - Classroom library book check out will be handled by the teacher.
- PreK classrooms will continue to use tables and chairs. Sit spots may be an option for PreK.
- PreK cots will be sanitized after use.
- No meeting/communal area in the classroom.

Clinic Space

- Nurse will see non-symptomatic students in her office.

- Students with symptoms who need additional attention or who are awaiting parent pick up will hold in the principal's office which will serve as clinic space as long as needed. Principal will share an office with the counselor and use a portable cart.
- Teachers will phone the nurse to retrieve students from the classroom who are symptomatic.

Stairways, Hallways, and Bathrooms

- Passing times in hallways and bathrooms will be more scheduled by grade levels.
- Students will wash hands in bathrooms and the number of students in bathrooms will be limited.
- Water Fountains:
 - Water fountains will not be utilized in schools. Water will be accessible via water bottle filling stations in most buildings, and students are encouraged to bring their own bottle.

Dismissal

- Grade levels will need to be dismissed in intervals with the traffic flow going one way.
- Car riders will need to be spaced out while waiting for parent pick up.
 - **Parents are not permitted in the building and will need to stay in their vehicle.**

After School Events, Special Events, Outside Visitors, or Parents by Appointment

- We will continue to stay up to date on guidance as we approach holidays and events that have been held during the school day as we will minimize or eliminate outside visitors.
- No field trips will be scheduled at this time.
- Evening events/family nights will be temporarily suspended or done virtually.
- Anyone with an appointment will follow sign-in procedures, will be required to wear masks, and meet in a designated area which will be sanitized after meeting with a student or meetings will be held virtually.
- Annual Case Review meetings will be held virtually.
- Kindergarten testing will be conducted on a one-on-one basis this summer. Families will be able to tour the school at that time.
- PreK staff may arrange an individual time to give families a tour of the classroom and building.
