What should I do?

Registration is for current students who will be returning for the 23-24 school year.

This year, we will.

- have in-person registration at all buildings
- you can register all students from any building location

Enrollment is for **NEW** students who have never attended an MCS school.

Reactivation - If you ever attended any MCS school at any time, left for any reason, and are now returning, you will need to visit your school so a building clerk can assist you in reactivating your registration.

Building administrators and clerks return on July 24, 2023, and will be available for assistance for in-person registration.


Online registration for returning and/or current students opens on July 10, 2023.

Registration Information

RETURNING students: online registration will open on July 10, 2023. Students who have already attended MCS in the previous school year in grades PreK-12 can visit <u>madison.k12.in.us</u> and log in to your <u>Skyward Family Access</u> account using the icon in the top right-hand corner of the website. Click on the online registration link from the Skylert page and follow the prompts to register for the 2023-2024 school year.



Transfer students: students who have legal settlement (their home address) outside of the MCS district and desire to attend one of the schools within the corporation during the **2023-2024** school year, must file a request with the MCS Board of Trustees prior to **August 9, 2023**.

Application form can be downloaded or picked up at the school buildings or at the MCS Administration Office, 2421 Wilson Avenue, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. or online at www.madison.k12.in.us. All completed forms must be returned to the Administration Office.

It is important that your student be enrolled before the first day of school to help ensure all transportation, student technology, and administrative items can be completed prior to student arrival.

NEW students (students <u>never</u> enrolled at MCS): <u>online</u> <u>enrollment</u> for new students is currently available. Once your account is created and activated, you will be able to access online registration.

Online Enrollment is for students who are BRAND NEW to the district and have NEVER attended Madison Consolidated Schools. **If you were a student at MCS at any time, left, and returned, you will need to visit the building and have the clerk assist you to reactivate your registration.

If you prefer to enroll in person, you may visit the main office of the school you will attend and there will be staff available to assist with new student registration. If you are unable to enroll online or attend the designated dates and times, please call the school office to set an appointment.

Meal Charges for 2023-2024 School Year

The cost for student meals for the 2023 - 2024 school year will be\$2.50 for elementary students and \$2.70 for junior and senior high school students. Still in place, is the FREE breakfast program where each student can receive one breakfast each day at no charge at any of our schools.

We realize this can be a considerable expense for some families. If you believe your family qualifies for the Free or Reduced Lunch Program, please complete the application included in online registration as soon as possible. If you are not sure of your eligibility, please <u>click here to check the guidelines</u> and for <u>Espanol click here</u>.



To keep lines moving, students will use the same 4-digit code to access their computer device and enter on the cafeteria key pad.

The school lunch program continues to be dedicated to feeding our students nutritious meals in the fastest and most pleasant manner possible. Menus will be available on our website, be sent home monthly with elementary students via student device, and posted at various locations in the junior and senior high schools to let students know what is being served. The menus will also be posted to our social media feeds on Facebook and Twitter @MCS_Indiana, on the radio, and available for download on our interactive food service website.

Breakfast Charges:

Student breakfast - First meal is FREE, additional meal price is \$1.35/meal Adult breakfast - \$2.50/meal

Lunch Charges:

Elementary student paid lunch - \$2.50/meal Secondary student paid lunch - \$2.70/meal Elementary & Secondary student reduced lunch - \$.40/meal Adult paid lunch - \$4.60/meal

**no fast food may be brought into the dining room during meal service hours by students or adults.

MCS participates in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs. Children from households that meet Federal income guidelines are eligible for free meals or reduced-price meals at \$.40 for lunch and breakfast is free.

The school lunch program continues to be dedicated to feeding our students nutritious meals in the fastest and most pleasant manner possible. Menus will be available on our website, be sent home monthly with elementary students via student device, and posted at various locations in the junior and senior high schools to let students know what is being served. The menus will also be posted to our social media feeds on Facebook and Twitter @MCS_Indiana, on the radio, and available for download on our interactive food service website.

Families are encouraged to apply for free or reduced lunches as soon as registration opens for the 2023-2024 school year. If you have any questions do not hesitate to contact Judy Brooks, Food Service Coordinator at jbrooks@madison.kl2.in.us.

An application for <u>free/reduced meals</u> (<u>Espanol</u>) may be completed if you feel you qualify for assistance. Households are encouraged to apply **before** the start of school to avoid unpaid meal charges. Students who are not approved for free or reduced-price meal benefits before the start of the school year will be charged for meals starting the first day of school. Meal charges accrued before the approval of a meal benefit application will be the responsibility of the household. Our goal is to notify parents within 48 hours of approval or denial of the application and further information on what, if any, additional rental costs are due.

Households currently receiving food stamps or Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) need only to list the child's name and food stamp or AFDC case number and sign the application. If you are directly certified for free meals, you will receive a letter. You do not need to complete a meal application if you are directly certified.

Children who receive free or reduced-price meal benefits are treated the same as children who pay for their meals. In the operation of child feeding programs, no child will be discriminated against because of race, color, age, national origin, sex, or handicap. If the household believes that they have been discriminated against, they should write immediately to the Secretary of Agriculture, Washington, D.C. 20250. Likewise, if they believe that they have been discriminated against regarding the Textbook Assistance Program, they should contact the Indiana Department of Education, Room 229, State House, Indianapolis, IN 46204-2798.

If a household does not agree with the school's decision on the application or the result of verification, they may wish to discuss it with a school official. They also have the right to a fair hearing. Efficiency and Accuracy Remain a Focus for Family Communication




It is vitally important that your school has accurate contact information on file. With the rate and pace that information is changing, we have to be able to communicate with our families quickly. Our goal is to be as timely and accurate with the information sent home and to do so efficiently we must have accurate information in our Skyward Family Access portal.

The district uses Skyward as the student management system for housing all student data. SchoolMessenger is the communication platform that ties to Skyward and enables mass communication via call or email to families from their school. Each morning around 5 a.m. there is a data pull from Skyward into SchoolMessenger when data is updated and refreshed. This ensures the most current information possible in our system (as provided by our families) in the event we need to communicate information from our schools.

The district and buildings use SchoolMessenger to communicate information on everything from weather delays and cancellations to reminders about school events that may require parental interaction, such as school picture orders or permission slip reminders. Notifications range from the district level to building-specific items and can arrive via email, phone call, text message, or a combination of the three - depending on the message and urgency level and the personalizations selected by each family. See below on how to personalize delivery.

We ask all of our users to be mindful of overload - whether that is a call and/or email, length of the message, and the time of delivery. This tool makes communication with hundreds of families easier to facilitate to ensure they receive the same information, in a timely manner, sometimes with a quick turnaround.

One quick way to access Skyward is from the <u>madison.k12.in.us</u> website. From the same place as online registration, click on the icon in the top right corner that looks like a group of people. Once in Skyward, click on the Family Access link and verify your information is up to date.

Personalize your delivery!

The **Skylert button**, located near the bottom of the left-side menu in Family Access, will take you to the notifications personalization page. From here, families can determine how they wish to be notified of messages coming from the school. A family can receive attendance information by either email or phone, they can determine what number is used for food service notifications, and how they wish to receive 'general' or reminder notifications coming from school.






Transportation TidBit
