Hello, 8th-grade families!

We have some exciting news and we need your help ahead of a Zoom meeting with your students and Ivy Tech Madison campus K-14 admissions personnel on Wednesday, May 11.

Ivy Tech Community College-Madison campus has a long-standing relationship with Madison Consolidated Schools offering a variety of dual credit courses available to your student while at MCHS.

Dual credit occurs when a student is simultaneously enrolled at Ivy Tech Madison and Madison Consolidated High School, and may therefore earn college and high school credit in the semester culminating in the mastery of the subject matter.

The cost of the tuition is covered by the school district, so they are provided at no expense to the student. This was approved a number of years ago by the Madison Consolidated Board of School Trustees. The courses are offered on the high school campus and taught by dual-credit certified high school teachers.

In order to qualify, students must complete the registration process prior to their freshman year of high school. Members of the K-14 admissions team will be conducting a Zoom Meeting with your student's College & Career or Health class on Wednesday, May 11 to help walk them through the necessary application. **They will need their social security number** in order to complete the form. Please make sure they have it with them in a safe location or know what it is so they can include it on their registration form. It must be on the form to qualify for dual credit classes moving forward. **This is a one-time application process and required for all students regardless of if they plan to take dual credit classes or not at this time.** It cannot be done retroactively.
