Our Core Value for the month of September is: **FREINDSHIP**. Friendship is using your words and actions to show others you care.



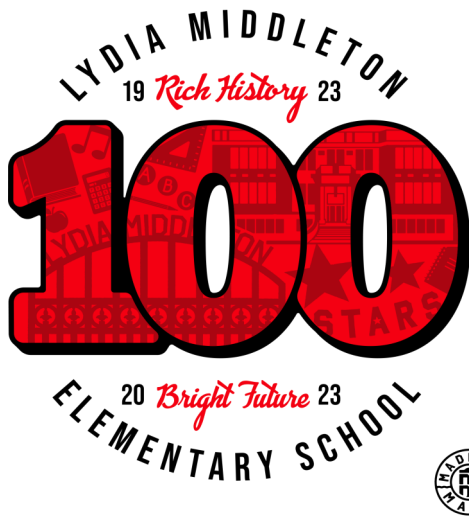
