Madison Consolidated Schools announces six scheduled eLearning days for the 2017-2018 school year.

Madison, IN: Madison Consolidated Schools uses eLearning days to enhance student learning in both good and inclement weather. The district has six scheduled secondary eLearning days for the 2017-2018 school year.

2017 - 2018 eLearning dates:

- Friday, September 1, 2017
- Friday, September 29, 2017
- Tuesday, November 7, 2017 (Optional for Grades K-4)
- Friday, January 12, 2018 (Optional for Grades K-4)
- Friday, February 16, 2018
- Friday, April 6, 2018

Grades 5 through 12:

Students at Madison Consolidated High School and Madison Junior High School, grades 5 through 12, have the opportunity to participate in eLearning days which are scheduled throughout the year. On scheduled eLearning days, high school and junior high students use their school issued devices to utilize technology via the internet using Google Classroom. Teachers are available to students, through various platforms, to answer any questions or actively collaborate on assignments as needs arise. On scheduled eLearning days, if a student does not have internet access, buildings are open, transportation is provided, meals are served, and a supervised study area is available; as if it were a normal school day.

Grades K through 4:

Elementary students, grades K-4, will use the scheduled eLearning days as in-class practice days. These practice days will allow them to become comfortable with the technology and Google Classroom should they wish to participate in the two optional eLearning days available for elementary school students.

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
