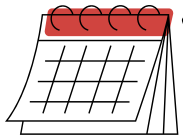
Employee of the Month

Along with a small gift, Michelle received all of the nomination forms from the students to enjoy. Michelle is a custodian at MJHS and takes great pride in her work.

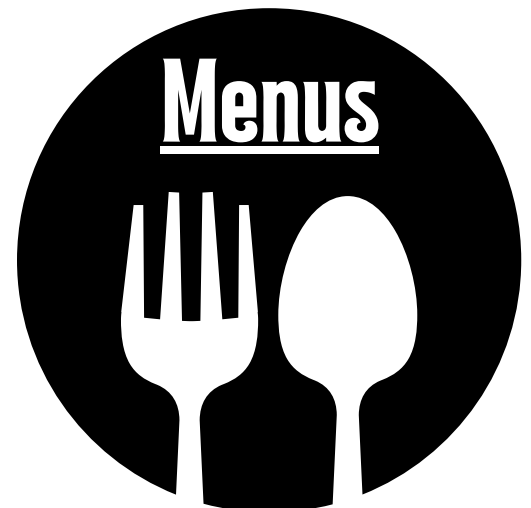
