6th Grade - Course Description

Students will be placed on a team of 6th grade teachers for Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Students will also take up to 4 elective courses over the course of the year. A “tech time” set aside for IXL and Reading Plus has been added as well as an enrichment block. The enrichment block is built into the end of the day for 6th graders and provides students the opportunity to fine-tune needed skills, complete in-depth student choice projects, and service learning.

Morning Arrival

- Doors open at 7:10am and class starts at 7:55am
- 6th-grade bus riders are dropped off at door #1 and students will then walk directly to the gym to wait until school starts.
- 6th-grade car riders are dropped off at the sidewalk between door #5 and door #4. Students will then walk directly to the gym to wait until school starts.
 - Cars will enter campus off of 7th Street and drive around the south side of the building to get to the sidewalk between door #5 and door #4 which are on the north side of the building.
- Breakfast will be free to all students again this year and will be served in the cafeteria.

Afternoon Dismissal

- MJHS has adopted a staggered dismissal
- 6th-grade car riders will be dismissed at 3:05pm and exit through door #1 to the parent pick up parking lot at the east end of the building
- 6th-grade bus riders will also be dismissed at 3:05pm
- 6th-grade teachers will escort small groups of students to their locations at the start of the year
- 5th-grade students will be dismissed at 3:13pm for car riders and 3:13pm for bus riders
- 7th and 8th-grade students will be dismissed at 3:10pm

Lunch

- 6th-grade students will eat in the cafeteria from 12:30pm-1:00pm with assigned seats based on their teacher to start the year.
- 6th-grade teachers will walk students to and from lunch as the year begins
