



#### Dress code:

- Pajama pants will NOT be a dress code violation.

#### Tardies:

• Will now be calculated by class period and disciplinary results will be assigned by total for the period and not collective total for all class periods.

#### Cell Phones:

 Can be visible and with students in the hallway, so long as they are not actively using them. Once in classrooms and tardy bell rings, it is up to teachers how they want them to be stored for the remainder of the instructional block.
