The MJHS Peer Counselors will have a lollipop sale this week during all lunch periods.

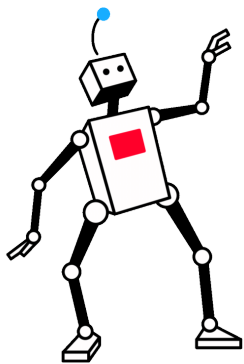

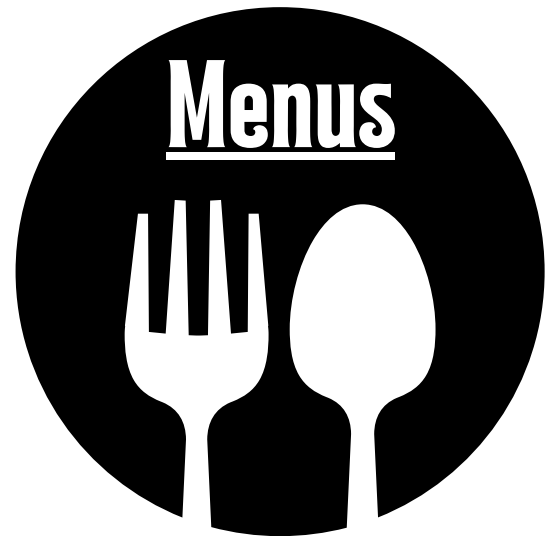

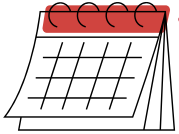

**Dress code:**

- Pajama pants will NOT be a dress code violation.
- Hoods and hats will not be permitted while in the hallway, but it is up to the teacher's discretion if they can be worn while in class.

**Tardies:**

- Will now be calculated by class period and disciplinary results will be assigned by total for the period and not collective total for all class periods.

**Cell Phones:**

- Can be visible and with students in the hallway, so long as they are not actively using them. Once in classrooms and tardy bell rings, it is up to teachers how they want them to be stored for the remainder of the instructional block.
