For 25 years, students at MJHS have participated in a canned food drive to benefit those in need. For the past several years, the proceeds have gone to The Jefferson County Clearing House - House of Hope Food Pantry to benefit hundreds of families struggling with food insecurity in our community.

This year, the stakes are even higher with a friendly competition thrown down last week.

Wear **Blue** and **Orange** to support the Coast Guard.


THURSDAY: AIR FORCE, SEPTEMBER 18, 1947 / SPACE FORCE, DECEMBER 20, 2019
